

TVA Facility Rules

To keep everyone safe during TVA tournaments and practices we ask that all spectators and participants observe the following rules.

- Good sportsmanship and good behavior shall be displayed at all times.
- No running or horseplay on the courts or in non-playing areas.
 - Please do not roll balls onto a court during play...leave balls for players to pick up. This could cause an injury to a player.
- All children under 14 years old not participating in on court activities must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Unattended children will be brought to parents and asked to remain with them.
- All ball handling and sports activities must be done on a court surface (not on concrete floor).
- All sports activities must be supervised by a TVA Coach or the TVA assigned and approved supervisor.
- No hitting ball or warm ups allowed against the walls.
- All players, spectators and participants must be dressed appropriately and only nonmarking athletic shoes are allowed on the court areas.
- All sports equipment & volleyballs shall only be used with permission and supervision of a TVA coach or the assigned and approved supervisor.
- Spectators, players, and coaches must observe the Codes of Conduct of USA Volleyball and the Florida Region as they pertain to each group.
- No outside food or drinks allowed in facility.

TVA reserves the right to remove anyone from the facility whose behavior violates any of the above rules. Any violation of the above rules will result in removal from the facility, and may result in you being banned from attending future events at the TVA facility. Local law enforcement will be contacted if necessary to resolve any disputes or altercations.
